The Snoezelen® Sensory and de-esculation rooms have many benefits, including:

Mental Health Support Helping inmates de-escalate during crises, reducing the need for solitary confinement.

Behavioural Management Offering a non-punitive way to manage challenging behaviours.

Trauma-Informed Care Providing a safe space for inmates to process trauma and reduce PTSD symptoms.

Rehabilitation Helping inmates develop coping strategies and emotional regulation skills for reintegration into society. **Staff Well-being** Reducing stress and the risk of confrontations for prison staff.








Snoezelen® Sensory Rooms in




