

Product Description

Our interactive carpet mats are designed to be visually stimulating and perfect for promoting movement, whether it's walking, crawling, or reaching. When pressure is applied to the mat, the lights turn on, and they turn off when the pressure is released. This interaction empowers users by giving them control and providing a visual reward.

The interactive nature of the mat also encourages motor skills development, making movement both motivating and stimulating. Additionally, the mat is spacious enough for multiple users, fostering social skills like turn-taking. Space Walk: blue Star, Circles, Shapes: black.



Product Safety and Care Instructions

Safety

Always supervise the use of this product.


Care and Maintenance

- Do not push heavy weights such as hoists over the carpet. Store the carpet flat.
- Do not bend or roll the carpet.
- The tip of the fibre optic produces the most brightness and if the pile becomes flattened there
 will be significant light loss.
- Regular cleaning with a vacuum cleaner will keep the pile in good condition.
- If soiling of the carpet occurs dry powder cleaners may be used or the carpet may be sponged with a damp cloth and mild detergent.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Do not use excessive amount of water when cleaning
- Do not use solvents on this surface as they will melt the plastic fibres
- Do not use spot cleaners such as tricloroethane111 or chewing gum removers
- Do not sllow contact with temperatures of 100°C or above

Since this light source contains LED rather than dichroic lamps, it is highly unlikely that the LED will need changing.




Product Assembly Guide/Installation

Installation

- Position the Carpet on the floor. When choosing the best place to position the carpet consider the following:
 - Do not place the carpet in a doorway or any area where heavy wear is likely
 - Position the light source out of reach of clients.
 - Never allow the client to pull on the flex
 - Keep the flex away from excessive heat sources
 - A maximum working temperature of 75°C is recommended.
- 2. Vacuum the carpet before use.
- Slide the boss into the metal tubing inside the front face of the light source, aligning the hole on the tubing with the screw in the boss.
- 4. Tighten the screw.
- 5. Plug the light source in and switch on.
- When the carpet is illuminated, connect the other lead from the carpet into the 5pin DIN plug at the back of the Light Source.
- 7. Apply pressure to the mats to activate the fibre optic display. The carpet can be walked on either with shoes or barefoot.

Note: A click can be heard as pressure is applied to the carpet. This is normal – it is the sound of the light source reacting to the pressure switch inside the carpet.

User Guide

Starting the products:

- Connect the carpet to the Light Source.
- Connect the power lead to the Light Source and plug in.
- Connect the other lead from the carpet into the 5-pin DIN plug at the back of the Light Source.
- Step on the carpet to activate the light.

Troubleshooting

No lights illuminating

Please check all connections from the Light Source to the mat.
