9. Starting Up

- No assembly is required for the Porter itself. Both the Single and Double Panel Porters arrive fully assembled.
- Make sure that your Panels are secured to the Porter before use.
- Use the castors to move the Porter as required, remembering to secure the brakes once the Porter is in the desired location, and before use.

10. Detailed Description

All the flexibility of a single porter, with even more advantages! Two panels can be used at one time and placed anywhere in a room. Excellent for use between two beds or chairs.

11. <u>Safety</u>

- Always supervise the use of this product.
- Use indoors in a dry environment.
- Before use, engage the brakes on the castors.
- Because of its weight, and water content, the Bubble Wall 18523 is not especially suited to a Porter this Panel should be wall mounted.

12. Technical Specification

13. Installation

- 1. Choose a suitable location for the Porter, making sure that the power cable will not be tripped over, pulled or come into contact with hot surfaces.
- 2. Insert the first panel into the side of the Porter where the L-shaped brackets are. Butt the bottom edge up to the wooden bar on the bottom of the Porter. Secure the panel to the porter by passing two screws through the two holes in the L-shaped bracket and into the back of the Panel. Plug the panel into the mains sockets on the bottom of the Porter.
- 3. Turn the Porter round and plug in the second panel into the mains sockets on the bottom of the Porter. Insert the second panel into the Porter. Again, butt this panel up to the wooden bar on the bottom of the Porter.
- 4. Both Panels should be joined with two connecting strips. Two white strips and two black strips are included as we offer a colour choice on our panels. Only two will be required at once to connect the panels. Using the screws provided (or the screws already in the top of the panels) pass a screw through each hole and into the panels.
- 5. The lead and plug from the multiple socket pass through the large hole on the side of the Porter and can be plugged into the mains supply (wall plug socket).
- 6. *Please note*: It is not recommended that any other products be connected to the Porter without seeking advice from a suitably qualified electrician.

14. Care and Maintenance

To clean the Porters use a mild household furniture polish and a duster, or wipe down using a damp cloth.
