9. Starting Up

- Choose a suitable location indoors or outdoors in a safe area.
- Decide how the blocks are to be used as a game, as building/stacking blocks, as falling pieces etc (see below).

10. Detailed Description

How high can you go? Take turns to remove blocks from the tower without it toppling down. Fun on a giant scale! Large pieces are easier to hold for the less dextrous.

11. Safety

• Use indoors or outdoors, in dry environments.

Size (each piece) 18 x 6 x 4.5cm

Material: Wooden Blocks with a material zipped storage bag

13. Installation

Ensure that a risk assessment of the area has been made and the surrounding area is clear from obstruction and access routes are clear to enable safe use of the product.


Giant Jenga blocks can be used in a variety of ways, either played individually or as a group activity.

Game 1:


• Start with two layers of two blocks each, evenly spaced as per diagram. These blocks should not be removed whilst playing the game.



- Continue with three blocks per layer using all the remaining blocks. Each layer is laid at right angles to the previous layer.
- To play. Remove a block in turn, placing the block on top of the tower with a maximum of three blocks per layer.



- Blocks cannot be removed from the top two completed layers.
- The winner is the last player placing a stable block on top the tower wins. Whomever makes the tower collapse is the loser and rebuilds the tower for the next challenge!



Game 2:

• Place the blocks in an upright position in a pattern, you could try different configurations like "figures of eight" or perhaps "snaking" patterns or straight lines (similar to dominos). Push the first one and watch the patterns fall.



Game 3:

• These large wooden blocks can be used to make interesting buildings and towers. Stack and make patterns.



14. Care and Maintenance

If you look after your Giant Jenga it should give you many years of service, but please observe the following:

- 1. Do not allow the wooden blocks to get wet.
- 2. Wipe off accidental marks/liquids using a mild detergent and a damp cloth, avoiding excessive amounts of water.
- 3. Do not use "Windolene" or ammonia based cleaners.
- 4. Do not use abrasive cleaners under any circumstances.
- 5. Dry after cleaning with soft cloth.
