10. Detailed Description

Provides deep pressure for additional sensory input. Masterfully crafted with a Baltic birch wood frame. Tension and pressure are easily adjusted to each user's specific needs. Cushioned foam rollers are covered in an easy-care polyurethane vinyl and they squeeze and release pressure evenly and consistently. With hand holds for portability. Colours may vary. Weight limit: 45kg (100 lbs)

11. <u>Safety</u>

- Allow plenty of room around the Squeezer to allow clients to safely enter and exit the rollers.



13. Installation

- Please check equipment immediately for any damage that may have resulted during shipping. If any damage has occurred, please contact ROMPA[®] immediately.
- 1. The Squeezer is supplied already assembled, although adjustments may be necessary to reduce or increase the compression tension. To adjust this, locate the tab hooks and the red rubber tube straps on each side of the Squeezer. There are two rubber tube straps on each side. Compression levels can be adjusted by how shallow or deep the tube strap is connected to the tab hooks.



2. Attach the tube straps to the lower most tab hook for the strongest compression. Connect the tube straps to the higher tab hooks for lesser compression.



- 3. Make sure that all adjustments are secure and tight before use.
- 4. Check all materials, stitching and connections for wear before using.

14. Care and Maintenance

- 1. Check for client allergies before using any chemical cleaners.
- 2. Wipe down with a soft cloth dampened with a mild soap solution and allow to air-dry naturally. Do not use large amounts of liquid and do not immerse any part of this product in water.
- 3. Use and store in a dry environment.
