9. Starting Up

All hanging equipment requires a minimum ceiling height of 8 feet/2.5metres and should be positioned a clear distance of 6 feet/1.8metres from adjacent walls and obstacles. All hanging equipment should be used with mats and cushioning of an appropriate thickness as well as helmets.

10. Detailed Description

Provides a connection between equipment and either an accessory and/or the final point of suspension. Screws closed. Steel and zinc-plated. Working load: 225kg (500 lbs).

11. <u>Safety</u>

- Always supervise the use of this product
- Do not use suspension equipment outside.

12. Technical Specification

Material:Steel, then zinc platedWorking Load:225kg (500 lbs)Size:11cm long, approximately 6cm wide; 1cm thick steel

14. Care and Maintenance

- All parts of the safety snap should be checked on a monthly basis and a record kept on the safety sheet provided.
- Worn parts should be replaced immediately.
- On the safety snap, check for wearing on the top and bottom of the snap where it rubs against the fixed point of motion or attached suspended equipment.
- Note: if wear exceeds 30% of the diameter of the safety snap do not use replace immediately.
- Ensure that the self-closing gate closes smoothly and all pins are secure.
- Check the fixed point of suspension (not included) for wear regularly and refer to the instructions for this for guidance on when to discontinue use and replace.
- Store out of reach in a safe place when not in use.
- Wipe with a dry cloth

15. Troubleshooting

• Discontinue use if any mechanisms are stiff, or the item is worn and replace.
