

9. Starting Up

There are no short-cuts to setting up Sensory Integration products. Read all instructions thoroughly before installing and using the Scooter Ramp and keep the instructions in a safe place.

10. <u>Detailed Description</u>

Ideal for promoting postural extension, motor co-ordination and fun activities. The wide top platform allows users to turn smaller scooters around. Made from extremely strong Baltic birch. Folds flat for easy storage. No tools are required for assembly. Weight capacity: 113kg (250 lbs).

11. Safety

Always supervise the use of this product.

This product is not a toy. Any activity involving motion, height, or rotation may cause serious injury. This product is intended for use under the supervision of trained professionals.

- Do not exceed the 113kg (250lbs) weight capacity.



13. Installation

 Please check equipment immediately for any damage that may have resulted during shipping. If any damage has occurred, please contact ROMPA® immediately.



- 1. Unfold the hinged platform.
- 2. Slide the stabilizer into both slots on the hinged platform.
- 3. Attach the ramp slide.
- 4. Use the bumper rails on the ramp slide if desired. The holes for these are pre-drilled. Use the shelf pins included to attach the rails (push these into the pre-drilled holes). Ensure that the ramp bumper rails are assembled correctly. One side of the ramp and its parts are marked with a 1 and the other side with a 2. The easy way to be sure everything lines up is to match the numbers. If a rail does not match up, then it should just be turned around and if they still do not line up, it simply goes on the other side.

14. Care and Maintenance

- 1. Wipe down with a soft cloth dampened with a very mild soap solution and allow to air-dry naturally. Do not use large amounts of liquid and do not immerse any part of this product in water. If this product were exposed to wet conditions or left outside, the moisture would cause the wood to swell and break apart.
- 2. Use and store in a dry environment.

15. <u>Troubleshooting</u>

If the rails are not fitting correctly into the pre-drilled holes and the rail seems to be lifting, looking similar to the photographs below it simply means that the ramp has been incorrectly assembled.





One side of the ramp and its parts are marked with a 1 and the other side with a 2. The easy way to be sure everything lines up is to match the numbers. If a rail does not match up, then it should just be turned around and if the shelf pins and pre-drilled holes still do not line up, it simply goes on the other side.
