9. Starting Up

- There are no short-cuts when setting up and using Sensory Integration equipment. Please keep these instructions in a safe place and refer to them as required.

10. Detailed Description

Helps clients to become calm and comfortable to encourage restful sleep. Suitable for clients weighing over 9kg (20 lbs) who have difficulty calming down to get to sleep. With a curved neck cut-out to help prevent the blanket from bunching around the face. Designed by an Occupational Therapist with over 25 years of experience. Triple-stitched for robustness and so the filling is safely contained. The hygienic filling is BPA-free, phthalate-free, and lead-free. As a general guideline, blanket weight should be from 15-25% of client body weight, although we recommend that you seek professional advice as to the suitability of these products for your particular client. Colours may vary. Machine washable.

These weighted blankets are specifically designed to give the sensation of deep pressure touch.

- They can help relax a person similar to swaddling a baby, getting a massage or having a loving hand rest on your shoulder.
- They can help with stress, melt downs and sleep among other things
- They can help falling asleep and staying asleep in an all-natural way

These sensory strategies are effective for most any one and have traditionally been used by many who have special needs including:

- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)
- Attention Deficit Disorder (ADD)
- Sensory Processing Disorder (SPD)

11. Safety

- Always supervise the use of this product
- The weight of the blanket must proportionately match the user's physique and weight.
- Use under the direct supervision of an Occupational Therapist
- Never allow the user's head to be covered by the blanket
- Make sure the client can quickly get in or out from under the blanket
- Vital signs must always be observable

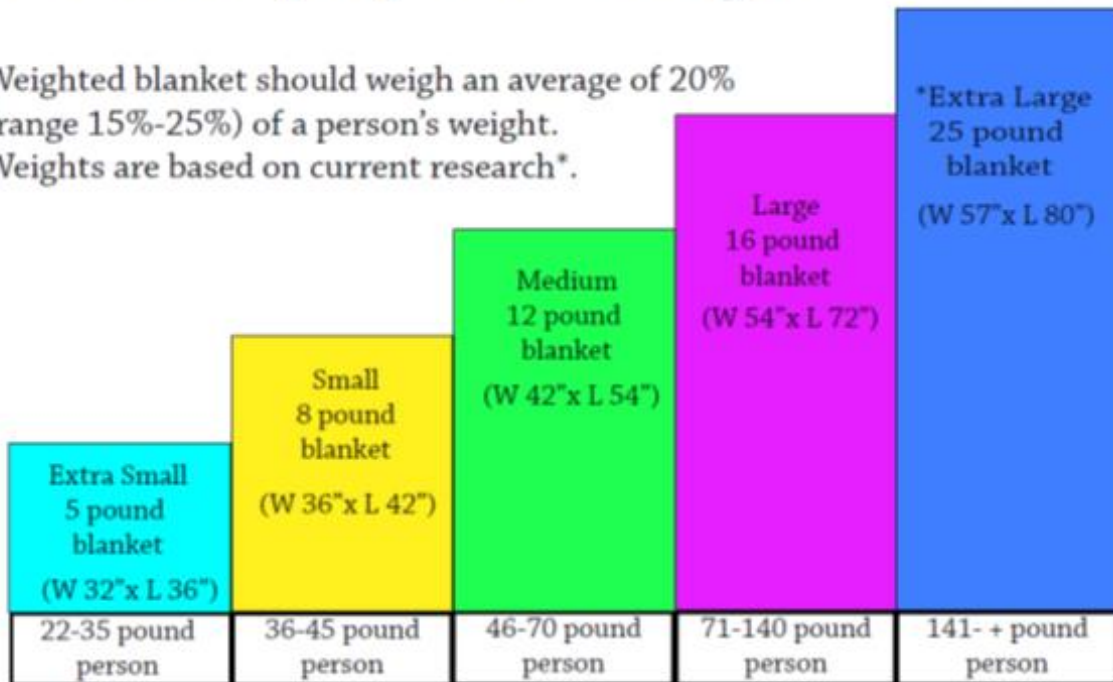

- Pellets are sewn into a cloth bag creating double protection and durability.
- 100% high quality soft cotton
- Double stitching for strength and maximum durability

Select the proper size weighted blanket.

Weighted blanket should weigh an average of 20% (range 15%-25%) of a person's weight. Weights are based on current research*.

13. Installation

1. If your client is using this product for the first time, allow time for him or her to adjust to it. To facilitate this, introduce the blanket to him or her in a familiar environment where the client feels safe and comfortable. Choose a time to introduce the blanket when your client is not agitated and already anxious.
2. Allow the client to discover the blanket in his/her own time – be patient and do not force the experience onto your client.
3. Place the blanket near some of the client's favourite things – when paired with favourite items, the blanket is likely to be accepted more readily.
4. Place the blanket near you when you sit or lay near your client. You go first – show your client that you enjoy using the blanket.
5. Promote positive associations with the blanket. Show the client that the blanket is safe, soft and will make them feel good. Choose positive language that they can understand. Smile and be relaxed yourself. Speak in a soothing calm voice. Build up the trust and security gradually.

14. Care and Maintenance

1. All the parts of this blanket should be checked on a regular basis (at least monthly, and more if the blanket is used often). Use a maintenance sheet (such as the example one provided) to record these checks.
2. Check the blanket for signs of wear and tear and repair or replace as appropriate.
3. Machine washable on the gentlest setting at a low temperature. For the heavier blankets (medium, Large and Extra Large) we suggest that you check with the washing machine manufacturer for weight capacity limits. It may be advisable to wash these larger blankets in industrial washing machines. Do not use bleach. The blankets can be machine dried on low heat or fluff cycle. The blankets will also dry relatively quickly when placed on drying racks with air circulation under them.
