- Make a template using a piece of paper trace the outline of the bracket and the holes. Hold this against your ceiling to mark the fixing points.
- Using appropriate fixtures, secure the Hanging Bracket in place.



Size: 13cmW x 30.6cmL x 11cm 10mm thick Weight: 3.5kg

#### 13. Installation

- 1. Choose an appropriate location for the Hanging Bracket. Make sure the location is suitable and will hold up to 450kg.
- 2. As a guide as to the location of the holes to be drilled in your surface, we recommend that you make a template using a piece of paper trace the outline of the bracket and the holes. Hold this against your ceiling to mark the fixing points. The diagram below is not to scale it is purely an approximate illustration of the fixing points.



- 3. Using appropriate fixtures, secure the Hanging Bracket in place. Fixtures (e.g. nuts/bolts) are not included as these will depend on the construction of the surface the Hanging Bracket will be attached to. Please purchase appropriate fixings, and seek professional advice as required.
- 4. Use the Hanging Bracket with appropriate suspension equipment Safety Snap, Height Adjuster, Safety Rotational Device etc. Thread your Safety Snap through the loop on the Hanging Bracket, and suspend other pieces of equipment from your Safety Snap, such as attaching a Rotational Device to the Safety Snap.

#### 14. Care and Maintenance

- 1. Regularly check the Hanging Bracket and maintain records of these checks. Check at least four times a year, especially if the Hanging Bracket is used often. Look for signs of excessive wear and tear. The bearing in the bracket allows movement to help to minimise wear, but given that the metal of the Safety Snap will be rubbing against the metal hook of the Hanging Bracket, signs of wear appear with frequent use. Replace the Hanging Bracket and Safety Snap as required.
- 2. Check that the Hanging Bracket is still securely in place.
